1. Treebones

Spend the night perched on the Pacific at [Treebones](#) in [Big Sur](#). Pitch your own tent or opt for one of the resort's, like this Sibley tent set up on one of Treebones' ocean view camp sites. The resort also offers cozy [yurts](#) with queen beds (a great choice for couples), as well as a topnotch restaurant and sushi bar overlooking the water. [More »](#)

2. Resort at Paws Up

Montana's [Resort at Paws Up](#) is camping at its most luxurious, with one- and two-bedroom tent amenities including ensuite bathrooms, camping butlers, chefs, and daily housekeeping. Choose from the resort's five campsites including the newest, [Cliffside Camp](#) with views of the Blackfoot River and Elk Creek, where some tents include decks with outdoor

3. Orenda

Explore the rolling hills of the [Adirondacks](#) in upstate New York at [Orenda](#), where six "canvas cabins" include wood-burning stoves, plush linens, Kiss My Face bath products, and free WiFi. The nightly camping fee also includes all food and beverage, including packed lunches for off-site activities like kayaking, hiking, and

[4. Fireside Resort](#)

Comfy king beds, a concierge, and daily cleaning services come standard in tents at [Fireside Jackson Hole](#). Located midway between the [Grand Teton National Park](#) entrance and the town of Jackson, the hotel makes the perfect home base for outdoor enthusiasts seeking hiking,

[5. Dunton River Camp](#)

A former cattle ranch from the late 1800s, [Dunton River Camp](#) now sits on the approximately 500 acres of meadows, streams, and forest in Cresto Ranch, Colorado. Eight prospector-style tents include ensuite bathrooms with soaking tubs, large private decks, and two

[6. Moab Under Canvas](#)

Located on 40 acres seven miles north of Moab, Utah [Moab Under Canvas](#) makes the most of its stunning desert surroundings. Tented accommodations range from teepees to Deluxe Tent Suites, which have private bathrooms, separate sleeping areas with king beds, and a wood burning stove with

Pitched in back of the [La Tourelle](#) hotel in Ithaca, New York, [Ithaca by Firelight](#)'s "Glampground" features tents with hardwood floors and plush bedding, plus a private balcony where guests can soak in the surroundings with a fresh pot of coffee or a cocktail from the bar.

The camp is located at the trailhead to [Buttermilk Falls](#), which forms part of the

Finger Lakes Trail system known for its gorges, waterfalls and swimming holes. Be sure to hit the daily happy hour, where guests receive a complimentary glass of [Finger Lakes Region](#) wine and, when the sun goes down, relax at the outdoor lounge, with a well-edited selection of games and books, comfy seats, and nightly campfires.
